

1st Sunday of Lent – 2020

“A Clean Heart Create For Me, O God...”

Last Wednesday with the imposition of the ash, we began the season of Lent that invites us to reflect on the human journey of fall and redemption. An on this First Sunday of Lent we are reminded of our common human experience of encountering temptation. Even Jesus was tempted while praying in the desert.

But what exactly is temptation? First of all, it is an offer that comes from the Evil One. He tries to lure us with a promise of pleasure, prosperity and prestige. He disguises what is evil and make it to appear good. And we need a discerning heart, one anchored in love of God to see through the seduction of the Evil One.

And the Good news is that like Jesus we are empowered by the love of God to say no to temptation. Jesus came into the world to proclaim that God’s love can and has conquered the evil one. We need not be afraid we only need to center ourselves in Christ and pray “A clean heart create for me, O God...” By offering himself on the cross, man’s journey has taken an upward turn. We are given the opportunity to choose to follow and live for Christ.

While Lent is a penitential season, inviting us to conversion, it is meant to be a season of hope and grace – that man’s destiny – our destiny is an eternity shared with the Father.




