


The feast is ready.

When hosting a feast or a banquet the two things that the every host is always worried with are: first will there be enough food for all those who will come and the second is will there be people coming to attend the banquet.

In this Sunday gospel, it is the case of the invited guest not attending. But host is just not ready to give up. He invites and continues to invite them. 'The feast is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy to come." And when those invited firmly refused, he quickly set his option B. This of course reflects the story of the relationship of God with the Jewish nation. When the chosen people refused His invitation, He then opened the invitation to anyone who wishes to come. It reveals to us that He can neither be controlled nor dictated to by anything in us, nor by any one of us. Generosity is His prerogative, not His obligation.

But the parable also would like to pause the question to us: How have we responded to his invitation? Are there more urgent matters that we need to attend to than being with the Lord? Hopefully the quarantine lockdown because of the Pandemic has given as the opportunity to reflect on the most important things in life.



The church cleaning ministry consists of four teams that rotate on a monthly basis. They are looking for any one who is interested in creating their own team to join the rotations.


- A team would consist of about 8 to 12 members who gather on a Saturday morning from 8:30 am to 9:30 am.
