



Mountains and high places in the scriptures are places of sacred encounters with God. In the first reading this Sunday Abraham was directed by the Lord to offer his son, Isaac, “...on a height that I will point out to you.” In the Gospel, Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain, where He was transfigured. We, too, are being invited by the Lord to ascend the mountain this Lent and there encounter the Lord. But not necessarily Mona Kea nor Moana Loa but the mountain in our hearts where a true transfiguration is to unfold if we would just open it to the Lord.

The transfiguration story reminds us that the Lenten season is a season of transformation. It is a season of renewing ourselves to return to how God intended us to be. Our prayers, fasting and acts of charity during this Lent are ways by which we come in contact with our the self which was made in the image and likeness of God – that which reflects our participation in the Divine. And share with our Lord Jesus that divine calling - “This is my beloved Son.”

We are God’s beloved sons and daughters. Let us go to the mountain of the Lord.




