## 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B - 2021

**“What God has joined together...”**

The gospel this Sunday tackles the everyday challenges a disciple is confronted with to be a true follower of the Lord. And one of them is about the reality of family and married life. Jesus today affirms the indissolubility of Marriage being in itself a Sacrament of the Church when He said: “What God has joined together...”

As a Sacrament, Marriage is not only about two people wanting to be together. First of all, it is much bigger than just the two of them. Its beginning is the plan of God for the individual. It is about a call that God himself has initiated for a person so that they may respond to His invitation to a life of holiness and in so doing participate in the sanctification of the whole world.

Thus while the gospel spoke of “It is not good for man to be alone,” human happiness is not the primary goal of marriage. Rather God’s primary goal for marriage is holiness. Thus, the Sacrament of Marriage is Sacred and Holy. The task of a Christian couple is to become partners in achieving God’s desire for them to be a reflection of his image and likeness. And their first challenge is to witness the holiness of God. And this is what the Church teaches us in Our Catholic Catechism No. 1603:

“The intimate community of life and love which constitutes the married state has been established by the Creator and endowed by him with its own proper laws. . . . God himself is the author of marriage.”<sup>87</sup> The vocation to marriage is written in the very nature of man and woman as they came from the hand of the Creator. Marriage is not a purely human institution despite the many variations it may have undergone through the centuries in different cultures, social structures, and spiritual attitudes. These differences should not cause us to forget its common and permanent characteristics. Although the dignity of this institution is not transparent everywhere with the same clarity,<sup>88</sup> some sense of the greatness of the matrimonial union exists in all cultures. “The well-being of the individual person and of both human and Christian society is closely bound up with the healthy state of conjugal and family life.”<sup>89</sup>


