26th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2021 (B) With Him or Against Him?

In today's gospel, Jesus reminded his disciples that there are only two kinds of people : those that are with him and those who are against him.

But what does it mean to be with Him? Well, we are told that God is at work in every time and every place. He can likewise work in every person and every group. Yes he can use priest bishops, priest and religious, teachers and professionals to make known his will but he can also use the little children, the ordinary laborers, the homeless, the disabled and elderlies to proclaim his words for us today. In fact, we can become an obstacle to God's work if we start thinking I am the only one who can proclaim God's word today. The Lord invites us to see Him at work in the lives of every person and be grateful for it.

The choices and decisions we make everyday, would reflect whether we made it for Christ or not. Like to choose whether we would go to mass today or not. Or when we choose to forgive a person who have hurt us or to choose to hate and plan to revenge. Similarly to choose to stand up for truth and justice is to stand up for Christ; to do nothing is to stand against Christ. Even the choice of our words when we speak to one another, can be either be for our love for Christ or it can be against Christ.

Let us take a moment to look back on the lives that we are living and the choices that we have made and will be making. Have we made a choice to be with Christ? I pray that we all do!




