

“There is need of only one thing.”

A lei of aloha welcomes every visitor of Hawaii. And behind every lei would be a prayerful wish for a visitor’s wellbeing as they stay in the island. But for the people of Hawaii, it represents a culture of hospitality.

This Sunday we are given a glimpse of what hospitality means for the people in the bible. The Jews regard hospitality as a God-given mandate for they themselves were strangers in a distant land and was welcomed into the promise land. The story of Abraham and that of Martha and Mary remind us to go out of our way to care for the neighbor. But at the end, it was the hosts, Abraham and Mary and Martha, who were surprised by the gifts that their guests brought with them – for Abraham the gift of a promise of a son and Mary and Martha the gift of Presence of Jesus.

Every time we welcome a guest into our home - be it a friend or a stranger, we might just be welcoming the Lord, Himself. As St. Benedict wrote: “LET ALL GUESTS who arrive be received like Christ, for he is going to say, "I came as a guest, and you received me."
