Trinity Sunday -2022

Trinity – Icon of Community of Divine Love

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. This is how we begin our prayer – invoking the presence of God who is Trinitarian – or as we call Him the Holy Trinity.

As we celebrate Trinity Sunday, we read in the Gospel Jesus reminding us “I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. 


