The Provincial Superior of the Daughters of St. Paul announces the closure of 4 of their locations including their Honolulu Media Center.

Sr. Donald Maria Lynch said, “Like many of you, our religious community has experienced the challenges of these times. Our love for God and all of you compels us to continually discern how to serve the Church more effectively through our religious consecration and evangelization. To do this, we are reconfiguring our presence to enable us to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to more people in our changing world.

And so we are reconfiguring our 13 physical locations across the continent to carry out our in-person and online media mission more effectively. **We will be consolidating our communities, and moving from our locations in Honolulu, Hawaii (to close during the summer of 2022); Chicago, Illinois (will close in the fall); Charleston, South Carolina (early 2023); and San Antonio, Texas (already closed).**

We realize closing these locations will leave a void, and to say that we will miss you in these cities is an understatement. While these changes we are making are painful, we trust that the Lord will grant growth and spiritual fruit through this process.
