Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord – August 6, 2023

“Lord, it is good that we are here!”

This Sunday, August 6, we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. In today’s gospel, witnessed by the apostles – Peter, James and John, Our Lord Jesus was transfigured from the ordinary human person to His glorified nature as the Beloved Son of the Father.

Our Catechism teaches us that :”Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the apostles' faith in anticipation of his Passion: the ascent on to the "high mountain" prepares for the ascent to Calvary. Christ, Head of the Church, manifests what his Body contains and radiates in the sacraments: "the hope of glory" (CCC568).

For us, the Transfiguration is to help us as disciples prepare for and live faithfully the life of glory that awaits all who chose to follow Christ. As Jesus was transfigured so we will also share in His transfiguration. We will experience trials and temptations along the way but the vision of the blissful life that awaits us can be a source of strength and encouragement.

But in the meantime today’s feast is a perfect opportunity to reflect on the “things that are above.” Our life, with all its blessings and trials, its successes and defeats, its beauty and ruggedness, lasts for a blink of an eye in comparison with eternity. With His Transfiguration, Jesus offers us the opportunity to be transfigured one day. And with St. Peter, we hopefully shall say: “Lord, it is good that we are here!”


