

Safety Committee Report to St. Joseph Church

St. Joseph's safety committee under the leadership of Father Poli Ty and chairperson Iris McGuire has completed the safety action plan for St. Joseph Church. The purpose of this plan is to ensure that St. Joseph Church and its parishioners are adequately prepared and trained to respond to church and parish emergency related situations, man-made or natural, and to ensure parishioner safety, safe evacuation, reducing injury to parishioners and guests, and to minimize property damage. Our plan was reviewed by St. Joseph's Parish Advisory Council and by Dara Perreira on the Bishop's Administrative Advisory Council of the Diocese.

Members who also served on the committee include Paul Akiona, Gwendolyn and Michael De-Coito, Mary Correa, Margaret and Bob Lucas, Charlene Miyashiro, Heidi Pana, Bernie Rasay, Carol Sobrado, Sr. and David Watson.

Their collaborative work on the action plan identified procedures set forth for the parishioners and their families, guests, visitors, parish administrators, staff, and volunteers of St. Joseph Church, to review and become familiar with for the safety and security of all and in the event of emergencies.

Our goal now is to help parishioners become familiar with the contents of this plan and assist in any way possible for the safety of our fellow parishioners and guests. We hope to conduct training sessions for ministries and interested individuals in the future. By doing so, we hope to maintain safety and security in our parish.



- True life is found in Christ, who is available to us in the Eucharist.


REFLECTION QUESTION(S)
