Feast of the Holy Family – Year "C" - 2024 The Holiness of the Family

Celebrating today the Feast of the Holy Family invites us to look at how our own families have been a seedbed for nurturing our Christian faith.

The family of Joseph, Mary, and Jesus mirrors a simple but deep piety by keeping up with the custom of going to Jerusalem to celebrate the feast of Passover. Nothing extraordinary for every pious Jewish family is expected to do the same. But when done wholeheartedly and not only as an obligation, it becomes an expression of true faith and love for God. And we know this because the boy Jesus grew up with the consciousness that the temple was truly the home of his Father. Visiting the temple must have been something Jesus looked forward to.
