My Grace is sufficient for you

What better assurance can we get from the Lord other than the words he gave to St. Paul : "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." So that instead of granting Paul's request to remove the thorn in his flesh, God offered him grace. And this Grace is who Jesus is for all of us but unfortunately, not everyone is ready to accept Him, just like the people of His time.

During the time of Jesus, the people of Israel were expecting that God will one day send their liberator from the foreign domination. He would be the Messiah. But to do so the one that they were expecting must be a powerful king like David. Thus, the difficulty of accepting Jesus, whom they know to be the carpenter the son of Mary despite the great deeds He has shown them. They have allowed their human prejudice to dictate how God would work in our lives. They want to control how God can offer them salvation.

Let us learn from Jesus. He experienced failures and disappointments, just as we do, but he did not let that overcome him. He continued on, with integrity, teaching and performing miracles, even though he could not do so in Nazareth. "The Father's grace was sufficient for Him."


