He had compassion for them.

After fulfilling the mission entrusted to them by Jesus, the apostles are being welcomed back by the Lord. Fully aware that they were worn out from the journey, Jesus suggest that they take some time to rest. "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." Jesus knew they need to recharge their spirits in prayer and recollection.

The disciples needed physical rest in order to recuperate and be revitalized. They also need a break from the pressure so as to remain calm and compose to minister to people. But most of all, they needed to replenish their spirit through prayer and simply being with Jesus.

And as it is true for the disciples, so it is for all of us. Engaged in the daily struggle of being a disciple and faithful witness of our Lord, it can be exhausting and draining. We need to immerse ourselves in the presence of God and be strengthened by His love. But like Jesus, we are reminded: "As he went ashore, he saw a great crowd; and he had *compassion* for them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things." We do not schedule the time when we have to show compassion. Every moment is a privileged moment to be the compassionate presence of God.


