

Feast of Corpus Christi – 2024 B

This is My Body

On this Feast of Corpus Christi, we honor Our Lord Jesus as He is truly and substantially present among us in the Holy Eucharist, particularly in the bread and wine that has been transformed into His Body and Blood. This is what is known as the doctrine of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, which all Catholics must adhere to. For every Catholic the transformed bread and wine are **truly and really** the Body and Blood of Christ and are not merely symbols.

But sadly, many do not believe in the doctrine of Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist or if they do believe, many have not appreciated and valued this gift of His Real Presence. So today, it will be good to meditate: "If I believe that I really receive the Body of Christ in Holy Communion, how do I show my respect and gratitude for this extra-ordinary gift of His Presence? To appreciate the Real Presence is to rediscover the simple but difficult gift of being present to each other. We have lost this gift because we have been led to believe that presence must be useful. We have forgotten that it is often in "useless," unpretentious, humble presence to each other that we feel consolation and comfort.

And as it is true with us, so it is with God's presence among us. Having God with us does not mean that God solves our problems, shows us the way out of our confusion, or offers answers for our many questions. He might do all of that, but his solidarity consists in the fact that he is willing to enter with us into our problems, confusions, and questions. This is the face of the compassion of God. And this is what makes the Eucharist a Sacrament of God's compassion for in the Eucharist God simply desires to be with us and make his presence known to us. A presence that cares, a presence that endures, a presence that is real.


What: Sanitize pews, esp "high" touch areas. Sweep & swiffer cement floors. Vacuum carpeted areas.


