Trinity Sunday – 2024 B

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

Any God who can fit my expectation and definition Is too small to be the one True god. Any creation by man’s desire, hopes, prejudices, selfishness, dreams and intellect is not God. Precisely it is man’s creation! God is and must remain a mystery to be true to Himself. But because God loves us with out limit, He chose to be near us and desires to journey with us.

“One God in three divine Persons. – The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit” This is how many of us had been introduced into the mystery of the Trinity which we celebrate this Sunday. But what does that mean?

Today’s feast gives us a glimpse of who God is. While He is truly transcendent and beyond our human comprehension, God chose, however, to be a God who is not beyond our reach nor be faceless spirit that we cannot get to know personally. We do get a glimpse of God in his creation and in our prayers and quiet reflections. But most of all, we get a glimpse of God when man lives at His Best - But at the same time, Trinity Sunday reminds us that God can become knowable and lovable not because of what I do, but because God chooses to be known and loved, chooses to enter our lives. Consequently, this feast also reminds of the complete outpouring of God’s love that is revealed in His Fatherly care for all of us.

Thus, the best way to understand the mystery that we celebrate today is to enter in to the life of the Trinity. And it begins by accepting that to believe in the Trinity is to believe in community. God is a communion of Three Persons. To believe in the Triune God is to believe in God who is One in three Divine Person because of love.

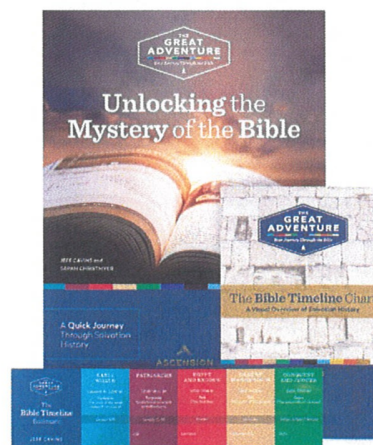

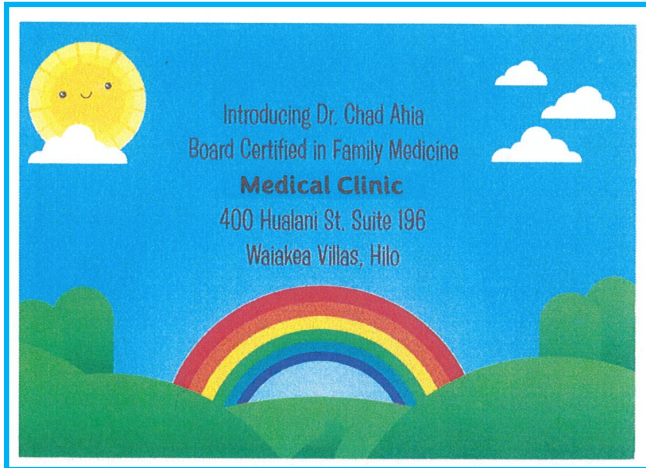
