27th Sunday in ordinary time - 2024 and the two shall become one flesh.

This Sunday's readings tell us that God wants us to be able to experience faithfulness and love. Not the kind that comes and goes but the steadfast and unfailing love that looks and feels like God's unconditional love. And to provide us with a manifestation of this seemingly impossible reality, God has given us the Sacrament of Matrimony. Those who choose to enter this sacred path are called to a life of unbreakable union of life and love made possible by the faithful love of God for us. We can read again and again that God has become flesh and dwells among us, but if we don't see that lived out then the word loses some of its power. Faithful and loving married persons bear the presence of God to all of us. They, in their free choice to love each other every day of their lives, put flesh and bones on the word of God.

Although the bible tells us that a married couple embracing their sacrament is the closest thing we will see to God's love for the people, all of us, married or not, can mirror that love to each other and to the world. We have choices to be faithful or not. Our choices reflect the chastity of our hearts, whether we are married or not. Each of us can choose for or against our oneness with each other and with all of God's creation.

As a Sacrament, Marriage is not only about two people wanting to be together. It is much bigger than just the two of them. Its beginning is the plan of God for the individual. It is about a call that God himself has initiated for a person so that they may respond to His invitation to a life of holiness and in so doing participate in the sanctification of the whole world.

On behalf of the Student Campus Ministry, we want to thank all the parishioners who purchased from Panda Express for our fundraiser.
