Palm Sunday 2025

"...by your holy cross you have redeemed the world."

As we hold our palms and have them blessed, we recall the moment the Lord Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem. And with this we usher in the beginning of the Holy Week meditating on the glorious Passion and Death of Jesus. This is the paradox of Palm Sunday: celebration and sorrow, glory and suffering, triumph and the cross.

It reveals something disconcerting but a truthful review of the human heart. How quickly we shift from friendship to nemesis, from loyalty to betrayal, from commitment to denial, from faith to fear. But t despite the frailty of the human heart, Lord Jesus remains steadfast in His love for us and His mission. He carried His cross with love, forgiving as he suffers, trusting the Father as he dies.

This week, we are invited to walk with the Lord on the way to the cross not as spectators but as disciples, who dare not runaway. Let us not rush to Easter morning without first standing at the foot of the cross.

We adore you O Christ and we bless you. Because by your holy cross vou have redeemed the world.

When you turn in your Rice bowls if they have coins in them we ask that you please put them into a zip-lock bag first. That will help to keep your contribution all together.



In a vision to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in 1935, our Lord Jesus revealed a powerful prayer that He wanted everyone to say -----the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

----and He promised extraordinary graces to those who would recite it:

Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy.... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy.... (Diary, 687).
