Easter 2025

"I am the Resurrection and the Life."

Early in the morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb. What she found, however, was not what she expected. The stone was rolled away. The tomb was empty.

The empty tomb, however, is not being presented to us as proof of Jesus' resurrection. It could be in our ordinary world a case of theft, a mistake, a prank. But the truth is, it is something more powerful. It is an invitation. The empty tomb invites us to faith – to believe in everything that Our Lord Jesus has promised and proclaimed. He wants us to know He is the Resurrection and the Life. And whoever believes in Him will have life eternal.

And we know Jesus is Risen, and Easter is real, when with His help, we make our own lives the sources of light and life for others; when our words heal and encourage; when our hearts become more alive with compassion; when we stand firm for the value of life itself in all its aspects. Easter is real when people are healed, consoled, and strengthened by the life-giving Christian love we show to a brother or sister. Easter is real when we become "sacraments" of the presence of the risen Christ, the Light of the world, and of the values which he taught during his life on earth.

The Resurrection is and will remain as mysterious to us today as it was to the early church. The empty tomb tells us very little about what and how it happened. But one thing it proclaims is that the tomb is not the place for the Risen Lord and so it will be for all those who put their faith in Him. It is true. The Lord is Risen!



----and He promised extraordinary graces to those who would recite it:

Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy.... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy.... (Diary, 687).
