# He had set fire upon the earth!

We live in a world where truth is often twisted, faith is mocked, and standing for what is right can make you unpopular. So what do we do? Do we go with the current or go against it?

Jesus chose to go against the current. He confronted the Jewish leadership with their hypocrisy. He opted to welcome the sinners and tax collectors. He preached compassion over legalism. In doing so, "He had set fire upon the earth. Consequently, instead of establishing peace, he was creating division." But is He not the Prince of Peace?

Indeed, He is! But He brings true peace, which is not rooted in compromise or comfort but one grounded in truth, conviction, and transformation. This is the peace that lasts and reflects the Kingdom of God. While it may seem to start from a conflict with the world, what arises is a deep conviction to follow Christ, no matter what. Such conviction is not loud or aggressive; rather, it is a quiet strength knowing where one is anchored.

Jesus warns of division, but not because He seeks to divide. It is because the truth divides, especially in a world that prefers comfort over commitment.

Hopefully, we will allow the fire of God's love to burn our hearts, purifying us and making us faithful witnesses of Christ.

All Catholic men are welcome.




May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, *Pilgrims of Hope*, a yearning for the treasures of heaven.
