

21ST Sunday in Ordinary Time - 2025

"Strive to enter through the narrow gate..."

To the question in the Gospel: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?, Jesus chose to redirect it by replying: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate..."

While salvation is a gift being offered to all, it needs to be accepted by the person. In fact, Jesus says, "STRIVE". In Greek, the word used is "agonizomai", which means to struggle, to wrestle, to give everything you have. And the reason for the striving is that the Gate is narrow! And not because God wants to keep people out, but because it requires a certain letting go of everything and anything that can not fit. Self-centeredness won't fit, and neither is selfishness. Likewise, unforgiveness, apathy, lukewarmness of faith, and a host of contradictory values will also not fit.

It is a matter

of personal decision if one chooses to enter this narrow gate. And more than just a path, this narrow gate is Jesus. Thus, it is all about entering into a real, living relationship with Our Lord Jesus.

As we go on in life in life we will need to pass through many gates. And finally, at the end, we will have to enter either a gate that leads to eternal damnation or a gate that leads to heaven. Thus, "Will only a few be saved?" is not the issue because God loves all of us and wills us to be saved. The issue is "Are we taking his invitation seriously?"


