"...And he who humbles himself will be exalted."

We live in a world that extols strength measured by success, status, or influence. But our Lord Jesus, throughout his life, offers a different vision. He invites his disciples to embrace a life of humility and find in it their lives' deepest strength. "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

What is humility? Humility is not pretending we are less than we truly are. It is not thinking badly of ourselves. Rather, humility is truth – the truth about who we are before God and others. But at the same time, acknowledging that whatever we are and have comes from God.

True humility does not weaken us but grounds us and becomes our source of strength. It frees us from comparing ourselves with others, from the exhausting need to prove our worth, and from the fear of not being recognized. Humility gives one genuine confidence, not in one's accomplishments, but in God, who loves us and desires our well-being.

And Jesus is our model of humility – "He who was God did not deem equality with God something to be grasped at but rather emptied himself and took the form of a slave..." (Philippians 2:6)


