What must I do to inherit eternal life?

What would be the most precious gift you have ever received? Did you earn or pay for it?

In today's Gospel, a scholar poses a big question to Our Lord: "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" At first glance, this appears to be a good question. It is respectful and spiritual, and something a good religious person would be preoccupied with.

But in truth, there is something deeply off about it. And Jesus recognized it. Because eternal life is not something we work our way into. It is not earned like a wage or achieved like a prize. It is a gift... a grace from the lord. Just as we don't work for an inheritance, eternal life is freely bestowed by the Lord on those who open themselves to a loving relationship with Him. It is given to a person out of the benevolence of the benefactor.

This does not mean that our actions do not matter. Love. Charity, justice, trust, prayer, reconciliation- these are all the fruits of faith. But we do not do them to buy heaven. We do them because we already live in the light of the One who loved us unconditionally.

Let us not fall into the trap of thinking we must earn our place in God's Kingdom. Let us, instead, receive the gift with gratitude, and let our lives be a joyful response to the love we've been shown.


