Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord – 2025

"You are witnesses of these things".

Forty days after Easter, we celebrate another great mystery and moment of hope, the Ascension of the Lord to heaven. At first glance, it might seem like a farewell, even a loss, but it is not. It is a new beginning! The Lord is leading us forward into the fullness of life.


