June 29 = Feasts of St. Peter and St. Paul - 2025

"I will build my Church."

Today, the church celebrates two great pillars of our faith: St. Peter and St. Paul. Though they were very different in personality, background, and mission, they were united in one purpose: to proclaim Christ and build His church.

Peter was a fisherman and one of the 12 apostles. He was the rock - impulsive but deeply passionate. He denied Jesus, yet he repented and became the leader of the community of disciples and willingly died for the faith. Paul, on the other hand, was a scholar. He was once a zealous jew and a persecutor of Christians. But encountering Christ, he became the apostle to the Gentiles. He, too, gave His life for the faith.

In the Gospel, Jesus asked His disciples a question that echoes through the centuries: "Who do you say that I am?" And Peter responded with boldness and faith: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." This moment is foundational – not just for Peter, but for all of us. Peter's confession of faith becomes the rock on which Christ builds His Church. It reminds us that faith in Jesus is the foundation of the Church and the heart of every Christian life.

The stories of Peter and Paul teach us that God calls all kinds of people, not because they are perfect, but because they are willing to say "YES" to grace. And while it is easy to admire Peter and Paul for being pillars of the Church, we must not forget that even the smallest nails are necessary to complete the Church! Without these small nails, the building will fall apart.

And Our Lord Jesus waits for your "yes" to Him.




May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, *Pilgrims of Hope*, a yearning for the treasures of heaven.
