FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

We are his people, the sheep of his flock.

My sheep hear my voice, Jesus says in today's Gospel. I know them, and they follow me.

Let us have the humility to seek and find him on his terms and not on our own. May the One we encounter in this Eucharist shelter us and shepherd us to springs of life-giving water and wipe away every tear from our eyes. May we be filled with joy and the Holy Spirit and be an instrument of salvation to the ends of the earth.
