"My peace I give to you"

Peace is one of the gifts of God that mankind long for today. And yet it seems so difficult to attain. Why?

"My peace I give to you" is the Lord loving promise for us. And he offers it to us as He sends the Holy Spirit, the Ddvocate. And it is not only just any kind of peace. It is "MY PEACE!" It is a peace that emanates from the person of Jesus and thus something different from what our world is offering. Christ's peace is not only about the absence of conflicts, struggles, hardships or war. This is the peace that allowed our Lord to sleep in the midst of a storm. This is the peace that let Him forgive on the cross. This is the peace that comes from knowing that the Father's love is stronger than death. It is the true SHALOM – the well-being that God desires for all His children.

And how do we prepare to receive this gift of Our Lord's peace? St. Augustine shares this holy insight: Peace is first "The serenity of the mind," that is, allowing Jesus to take control of our thoughts, our fears and our worries. Second is "the simplicity of the heart" that is, being contented with what we have and what we have received as gifts from God. And finally, third is the "tranquility of the soul" that is, being fully reconciled with God and others.

Are we ready to receive this gift of peace?

We praise and thank you for the many gifts that you have given to our graduates, and for bringing them to this important milestone in their lives.


We ask you to bless them, keep their faith strong, and remain with them always.
