Otherwise, you must provide a Permission Letter from the Parish clergy to transfer to St. Joseph Church in Hilo.

- 3. They must be Catholics who have already received all Sacraments of Initiation to include: The Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, First Holy Communion, and First Holy Confession.
- 4. They must lead a life in harmony with the Catholic faith and participating in Church regularly. (i.e. Eucharist, Prayer & Parish Life, Holy Confessions, Care for the Poor, Adhere to Canon Laws on Marriage & Children or Single Life, etc.)
- 5. If Sponsor or Godparent is married, they must be married in the Catholic Church. Those who are married outside the church or who are living together with their partner may not be Godparents or Sponsors.
- 6. Parents of the person to be initiated may not serve as Godparents/Sponsors.
- 7. Please call the office or talk to your instructor if you need assistance with meeting these requirements.
